Ida B Wells was born a slave in the height of the Civil War in 1862 After the ratification of the Thirteenth Amendment officially ended slavery in the United States, Ida's family became active in the Republican Party and the Freedman's Aid Society Tragedy struck the Wells family in 1878 when Ida's parents and one of her brothers
